

# HomeLink®

GARAGE DOOR OPENER



- 1 While the car is ON, hold the handheld garage door transmitter 1-3 inches from the HomeLink® button you want to program in the vehicle.
- 2 Push and hold both the HomeLink® button being programmed and the button on the garage door transmitter.

## TO ERASE ALL SET CHANNELS:

Push and hold the two outside HomeLink® buttons for 20 seconds until the orange indicator flashes. An individual channel cannot be erased.



## Rolling or Non-Rolling?

Check your garage door opener motor in your garage for a “LEARN” or “TRAIN” button by the hanging antenna. If you have one of these, you have a Rolling Code garage door opener.

- 3 **For Non-Rolling Code** garage door openers, watch for the indicator light to go constant.  
**For Rolling Code** garage door openers, watch for the indicator light to go from a slow blink to blinking rapidly.
- 4 **For Rolling Code** garage door openers only, firmly push and release the “LEARN” or “TRAIN” button on your garage door opener motor in your garage, then push the HomeLink® button in your vehicle for two long presses.
- 5 If the programming was successful, your garage door should open and close with your chosen HomeLink® button.

## Did You Know You May Have An Audible Pedestrian Warning System?

In Hybrid vehicles (in electric mode only), a sound is emitted to alert pedestrians that your vehicle is approaching. The sound will increase or decrease in volume depending on the varying speed of the vehicle.

## ACTIVATE YOUR REMOTE SERVICES

- 1 Press "Apps" on the touchscreen.
- 2 Press "Activate Services".
- 3 Press "Activate Now".
- 4 There are two ways to activate: via email or via an agent. On the next page, you can either enter your name and email, or press "Call An Agent" to directly speak with someone.

### TIP:

You can use your remote commands from the Uconnect App, your Owner's Site account, or by calling an agent.

However, not all remote commands will work when calling the agent.

## Pair a Phone

1

Make sure Bluetooth® is enabled on your mobile device.

2

With the vehicle in the ACC or ON/RUN position, press the Phone button in the vehicle's touchscreen menu bar.

3

Press "Pairing" and then press "Paired Phones and Audio Devices".

4

Select "Add Device" then follow the prompts on your phone and in the touchscreen.

### KEEP IN MIND:

Some mobile phones will require you to enter a PIN as part of the connection process. For more detailed connecting instructions, refer to "Phone Operation" in your Uconnect radio book.



## Ready to **remove** a phone or audio device?



- 1 Press the Pairing button on the touchscreen.
- 2 Press "Paired Phones and Audio Devices".
- 3 Press "Settings" next to the phone or device you want to remove.
- 4 Press "Delete Device".
- 5 Press "X" to exit the settings screen. The device should be removed.

## YOU MAY ALSO BE ABLE TO **CONNECT YOUR APPS**

If your vehicle is equipped with Android Auto™ & Apple CarPlay®, connect your unlocked smartphone to one of the media USB ports in your vehicle. Once connected and recognized, the Android Auto™ or Apple CarPlay® icon will replace the phone icon on your personalized menu bar.

### KEEP IN MIND:



**For Android™ Users**, if the Android Auto™ App was not previously downloaded, it will download the first time you plug in your device.



**For Apple® Users**, Apple CarPlay® is only compatible with iPhone5® or later and requires Siri being enabled in Settings.

# 4x4 Operation

## FIVE-POSITION TRANSFER CASE

### 2H (2WD High)

Used for normal street and highway driving.

### 4H AUTO (4WD High Auto)

Sends power to the front wheels.

### 4H PART TIME (4WD High Part Time)

Forces the front and rear wheels to rotate at the same speed.

### N (Neutral)

Used for flat towing behind another vehicle.

### 4L (4WD Low)

Provides low-speed four-wheel drive. Forces the front and rear wheels to rotate at the same speed.

If your vehicle is equipped with a four-position transfer case, see "Four-Wheel Drive Operation" in your Owner's Manual.



### AXLE LOCK OFF

To unlock the axles, push the axle lock **OFF** button.

### TIP:

When the rear axle is locked, pushing the switch down again will lock or unlock the front axle.

### OFF ROAD+

When activated, the vehicle's performance will improve depending on which 4WD mode is activated.



### AXLE LOCK SWITCH

- ▲ Push the switch up to lock the front axle & rear axle.
- ▼ Push the switch down to lock the rear axle only.

If your vehicle is equipped with Tru-Lok, see "Four-Wheel Drive Operation" in your Owner's Manual.

### SWAY BAR DISCONNECT

Shift to either 4WD High or 4WD Low and push the **SWAY BAR** button.

### KEEP IN MIND:

Sway Bar Disconnect should be off during normal driving conditions.
